

Introduction to Vaastu Shastras and Pranava Veda

This course is an exploration of the fundamental mysteries - theoretical and scientific principles - that form the foundation of Vaastu Shastras, Building Architecture of Sthapatya Veda, and Mayonic Science and Technology. Practicum 1: Applied Mayonic Science and Technology
